



## **Live Lent: Embracing Justice**

This year we will be using the Church of England's "Live Lent" booklet for our Lent Course. They will be at Brompton Church beginning on March 9th at 7pm and will last about an hour. The information from the website says

"Each year at the start of Lent, Christians are challenged to turn away from sin and towards new life. Together we acknowledge that our own lives, our communities and our world stand in need of God's redeeming and transforming power. Live Lent: Embracing Justice is the Church of England's theme for Lent 2022. It invites us to examine our own lives truthfully, to see the world more deeply and to pray – for the church and the world far and near – that 'justice may roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream' (Amos 4.24).

The Booklet offers a daily Bible reading, a short reflection and a prayer, as well as a practical challenge for each day of Lent. Each week follows a different thread through the many stories of justice in the Bible to explore how God works with humanity to bring justice, wholeness and salvation to all."

Hope that you may be able to be there - you don't have to come to all the sessions. Please let me know if you would like a booklet.


