



## "Alcuin of York"

Alcuin of York (735-804AD) had a long career as a teacher and scholar, first at the school at York now known as St Peter's School, York (founded AD 627) and later he worked at the Carolingian court as Charlemagne's leading advisor on ecclesiastical and educational affairs. He was a sort of 'Minster of Culture' during Charlemagne's reign. From 796 until his death, he was abbot of the great monastery of St. Martin of Tours. He wrote many books on theology, ethics and philosophy as well as books of poetry.

He also had a significant role in determining the sort of script that was used at the time. He selected and improved what was called the Carolingian Minuscule Script. This included a mixture of upper- and lower-case forms and became the easiest script to read. Mainly for this reason he has been seen as an important person in the history of calligraphy, typography and printing.

I first learned about him when I was student librarian at Edinburgh Theological College. We had a number of books produced by the Alcuin Society, which was named in his honour. The fact that people produced such outstanding books in that society is something that had a great effect on me and encouraged me to think about printing and bookbinding years later.

He is one of our local saints of whom we should be very proud for the profound effect he had on European culture and in the world of calligraphy and bookbinding.




